

**Cold Spring City Council  
July 22, 2013**

At the opening of the July 22, 2013, council meeting, Mayor Mark Stoeber stated that tonight we welcome Cassidy Witt, winner of the Cline Elementary Mayor of the Day raffle, as our Honorary Mayor. This is the 4<sup>th</sup> year that the city of Cold Spring has participated with this event. Mayor Stoeber presented a plaque to Cassidy Witt, and asked her to take her place on the dais to start the meeting.

The regular meeting of the Cold Spring City Council was called to order by Honorary Mayor Cassidy Witt of Cline Elementary School, with Mayor Mark Stoeber assisting. Pledge to the flag and prayer was led by the City Clerk. Cassidy Witt called the roll call which showed the following council members present – Lisa Cavanaugh, Lou Gerdig, Dave Guidugli, Rob Moore, and Kathy Noel - excused was Adam Sandfoss. Also present were Police Chief Ed Burk, City Clerk Rita Seger, Administrative Officer Stephen Taylor and Attorney Brandon Voelker,

Cassidy Witt pointed out exits from Council Chambers, per Fire Department regulations.

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda

Items of interest to the community were reviewed by Honorary Mayor Witt. The next Movie in the Park will be held on Saturday, June 27<sup>th</sup> at our Municipal Park at dusk. The movie will be *Wreck It Ralph*. Rob Moore announced the winner of the July Yard of the Month as William Bertram, 509 Darlas Drive. He congratulated him on his beautiful yard, and he will receive a photograph of his yard, a gift certificate, and a “Yard of the Month” sign will be placed in his yard. Honorary Mayor Witt stated that on Saturday, August 10<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm the Kentucky Symphony Orchestra will play at our Municipal Park, in the field behind the city building. Honorary Mayor Witt stated that there were no old business items for discussion, and no new business items on the agenda.
