

**Cold Spring Planning & Zoning
November 28, 2018**

The public hearing for input from residents in regards to the comprehensive plan of the Cold Spring Planning and Zoning Commission was called to order by Chairman Mike Foulks. Pledge to the flag was led by the city clerk. Roll call showed the following present – Mike Foulks, Robin Hahn, Ron Schumacher, Steve Popovich, Glenn Kukla, and Sam Conner. Laura Meiners was absent. Also, present were City Clerk Robin Sweeney, City Attorney Brandon Voelker and Wendy Moeller with Compass Point Planning.

Mike Foulks pointed out the exits from the building, per Fire Department regulations.

Public Hearings – Public input for the Comprehensive Plan. Mike Foulks advised the audience that the draft plan was posted online for review. Comments centered on the SDA Zone within the Comprehensive Plan. It was explained to the public that the Comprehensive Plan and SDA Zoning are separate entities, and any changes to the SDA Zone can be brought to bear through text changes submitted by Planning and Zoning, or Council. The Comprehensive Plan does not provide for any zone changes. Language revisions for the Comprehensive Plan were discussed for consideration. A power outage caused the meeting to adjourn at approximately 7:54pm. Steve Popovich made a motion to adjourn. Sam Conner seconded the motion. **All in favor. Motion passed.**
