ORDINANCE NO. 20-1066**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES  
FOR THE ROBERT J. BARTH PARK**

**Whereas**, the City of Cold Spring has recently opened the Robert J. Barth Park, a public property that include a lake and trail around the lake, as well as plans for future other amenities; and

**Whereas**, Robert J. Barth Park is unlike the other Cold Spring City Parks; and

**Whereas**, the City of Cold Spring is desirous of establishing rules for the park, in addition to those already set forth by prior ordinance for other parks in the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COLD  
SPRING, COUNTY OF CAMPBELL, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:**

**Section I**

**Robert J. Barth Park Rules/Regulations:**

The following Rules and Regulations are established for Robert J. Barth Park, these Rules/Regulations shall be in addition to, any other set forth by City Ordinance:

1. No Boating of any kind, whether by motor, kayak, paddle board or other similar floating device.
2. No motorized vehicles of any type allowed (ADA Approved Scooters allowed).
3. No glass containers of any kind.
4. No chairs or other similar type items permitted on the trail.
5. No swimming.
6. No alcoholic beverage.

**Section II**

The penalty for violation of this Ordinance shall be \$100 for a first offense, \$200 for a second offense, \$300 for a third offense, \$400 for a fourth offense, \$500 for each offense thereafter.

**Section III**

That any section, or part of any section, or any provision of this Ordinance which is declared invalid by a Court of appropriate jurisdiction, for any reason, such declaration shall not invalidate, or adversely affect, the remainder of this Ordinance.

**Section IV**

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published, and recorded according to law.
