### Old Business:

Ordinance 21-1074, 2<sup>nd</sup> reading to adopt An ordinance of the City of Cold Spring in Campbell County Kentucky providing for the annual assessment of all real estate and personal/tangible property, including motor vehicles, subject to taxation within the City of Cold Spring for the fiscal year 2021-2022, pursuant to the Campbell County assessor's property valuation assessment, and levying an ad valorem tax thereon for city purposes; and providing for the payment and collection of such taxes and the penalties and interest thereon; and establishing solid waste collection and removal, including curbside recycling, and describing the purpose for which the taxes so collected shall be appropriated and used. Paul Kloeker made a motion. Adam Sandfoss seconded the motion. The rates have gone down from last year. The real property tax rate is .153 for each \$100 dollars of the assessed value, the personal/tangible tax rate is .169 per \$100 of the assessed value, the motor vehicles tax rate is .169 per \$100 of the assessed value. The 2022 trash rate is \$219.00. Roll call vote showed 4 yeses and 0 noes. Motion passed.
