US 27 (Alexandria Pike) – Phase 1 – Martha Layne Collins Boulevard to Link Lane

The length of US 27 (Alexandria Pike) Phase 1 is approximately 1.41 miles (7,470 feet). The character of US 27 (Alexandria Pike) is more urban in nature on this north end with higher traffic volumes (an average daily traffic of 39,545 vehicles per day was collected in 2024 at Henry Court), lower speeds (posted speed limit of 40 mph), curb and gutter section, sidewalk, higher density development of properties adjacent to the corridor, and with numerous intersections / driveways / site access points. Within Phase 1, there are approximately 51 intersections and in 2021, 2022, and 2023, 179 crashes were reported.
