### Ordinance 25-1104:

• 1st reading to approve an ordinance amending the City of Cold Spring budget and pay plan for the fiscal year July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026. Chris Ampfer made a motion, second by Adam Sandfoss. Lisa Cavanaugh requested clarification on the items included in the budget amendment. The amendment provides funding for the Municipal Park playset addition, replacement of the Friendship Park playset, adjustments to the pay plan, and participation in Social Security. There was discussion about the timeline for the playground upgrades. Roll call vote shows 6 yes and 0 no. Motion passed.

#### Ordinance 25-1105:

• 1st reading to approve an ordinance amending the City of Cold Spring's Code of Ordinances RE: Peddlers, Itinerant merchants, and solicitors. Lisa Cavanaugh made a motion, second by Cindy Moore. Cindy Moore wanted to clarify that this would not include school organizations and non-profits. There was discussion about the violations for those who may be non-compliant. Roll call vote shows 6 yes and 0 no. Motion passed.
